

NCAA Bylaws: 16.1.4 Types of Awards, Awarding Agencies Maximum Value and Numbers of Awards

Athletics awards given to individual student-athletes shall be limited to those approved or administered by the member institution, its conference or an approved agency...and shall be limited in value and number... Awards received for intercollegiate athletics participation may not be sold, exchanged or assigned for another item of value, even if the student-athlete's name or picture does not appear on the award. Each of the following subsections is independent of the others so that it is permissible for an individual student-athlete to receive the awards described in all subsections.

- 16.1.4.1.1 Senior Scholar-Athlete Award
- 16.1.4.2 Awards for Winning Conference and National Championships
- 16.1.4.3 Special Achievement Awards

Forms Used for Documentation:

1. Monetary Awards Summary

Individuals and Departments Involved:

1. Coach
2. Compliance Office
3. Athletics Business Office

Policy:

1. Head coaches are responsible to disclose to the Compliance Office in writing a summary of all awards during the academic year at the conclusion of their season and on/or after their team banquet.
2. Student-athletes may not receive any type of award that is not approved or administered by the NCAA, C-USA, Marshall University or an approved agency.

Procedure:

1. At the conclusion of a team's season, the head coach will fill out the *Monetary Awards Summary Form*. This form needs to include all student-athletes that received any type of award during the season.
2. The form is submitted to the Compliance Office for review and then sent on to the Athletics Business Office for a final review.
